

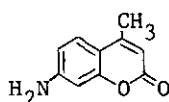
A NOVEL FLUOROGENIC SUBSTRATE FOR CHYMOTRYPSIN
— 4-AMINO-7-NITROBENZO-2-OXA-1,3-DIAZOLE DERIVATIVES —

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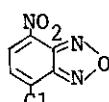
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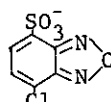
In the course of exploring a sensitive fluorometric assay for amidase activity of hydrolytic enzymes¹⁾ such as leucine aminopeptidase²⁾, trypsin and so on, we have been noticed usefulness of 7-amino-4-methylcoumarin(1) and its amide derivatives as a useful fluorogenic substrates.

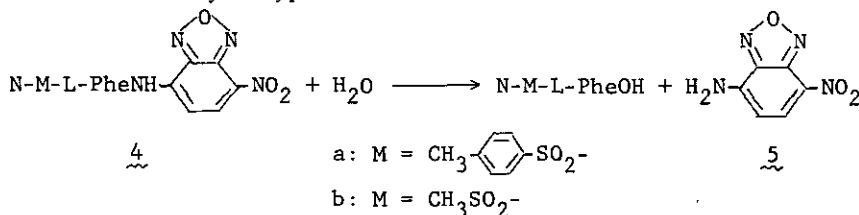


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Recently, 4-chloro-7-nitro or 7-sulfobenzo-2-oxa-1,3-diazole(2 or 3) have been used as a fluorogenic probe in biological research³⁾. A benzo-2-oxa-1,3-diazole system is expected to be a promising candidate as a fluorogenic amine. We describe the preparation of 7-(N-tosyl or N-mesyl-L-phenylalanyl)amino-4-nitrobenzo-2-oxa-1,3-diazole(4) and its ability to serve as a sensitive fluorogenic substrate for chymotrypsin.
