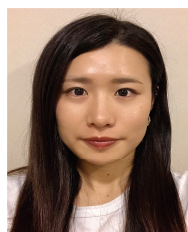
Akitomo Kasahara [Title: Control of Peptide Conformation by Cyclized Tryptophan](#)
